

Covid 19 Protocols

Updated September 2022

- Positive Case
 - If an individual tests positive for covid, they are required to isolate for five days, and can return on Day 6 if symptoms have improved and they are fever free for 24 hours without medication.
 - Masking while in school buildings on days 6-10 is required.
 - Individuals should not return to school if they are still experiencing symptoms, even if 5 days have passed.
 - Day 0 is first day of symptoms or day of positive test (whichever is first)
- Close Contacts
 - Encouraged to wear a mask indoors for 10 days
 - Test if symptoms develop
- Masking
 - Low to Medium Community Transmission
 - Masking is optional
 - High Community Transmission
 - Universal Indoor Masking (with the option to opt out)
 - Close Contacts recommended to wear a mask for 10 days following exposure
 - Individuals with covid symptoms coming to clinic will be required to wear a mask
