

### **If an individual tests Positive for Covid**

REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS

#### **Isolation:**

**Stay home for 10 Days and ISOLATE away from other family members.**

#### **If Asymptomatic:**

Day 0 is the day of the Positive test

Isolate for 10 Days

May return to school on DAY 11 if they remain asymptomatic

#### **If Symptomatic:**

Day 0 Starts on the first day of Symptom onset

Isolate for 10 Days

May return on Day 10 if symptoms have resolved and they are fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication

### **If an Individual is a Close Contact**

**All close contacts are recommended to get a covid test after Day 5**

A close contact is defined as:

- Students are considered a close contact if they are within 3 feet of a positive regardless of masks on or off
- Students are considered a close contact if they are within 6 feet of a positive individual if masks are not worn or not worn correctly by both parties
- Students are considered a close contact if within 6 feet of a positive adult regardless of masks on or off
- Adults are close contacts if within 6 feet of a positive individual with or without masks

#### **Close Contacts who are vaccinated:**

(Received a Covid 19 Booster or completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months or completed the primary series of J&J(Janssen) vaccine within the last 2 months)

- Attend school
- Wear a mask while around others, if masking is not possible (eating/naptime) be 6 feet away from others
- Day 0 is the last day of contact

IF they develop symptoms in the 14 days following contact - STAY HOME and test

**Close Contacts who are unvaccinated, partially vaccinated, OR adults who are overdue for a booster dose:**

With Testing

- Stay home and quarantine for 5 days
- Day 0 is the last day of contact
- Return to school on Day 6 if they meet the following criteria
  - Asymptomatic
  - Wear a mask while around others, if masking is not possible (eating/naptime) be 6 feet away from others
- If develop symptoms within 14 Days of exposure, stay home and test

Continuous Home Exposure:

A child/parent is under continuous exposure to a Covid positive individual in their home, where the child/parent cannot isolate or mask effectively, they will begin quarantine at the end of the isolation period.

**Changes in Vaccination Status Per the CDC**

**Vaccinated Individual is defined as someone who**

- Has received a BOOSTER
- Is 5-17 years old and has completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccines within the last 6 months
- Has completed the primary series of J&J(Janssen) within the last 2 months
- Recovered from Covid in the last 90 days (this is interim guidance, awaiting more information from CDC)

If none of this applies to you, then you will be considered an unvaccinated individual.
